Winterize Your Pool the Right Way & Relax Until Spring

Now that Fall is rapidly approaching, there will soon come a day when you will have to cover your pool and say goodbye until next Spring. By properly preparing your pool for the winter, you will make closing it simpler and opening your pool next year a cinch. **No matter when you decide to close your pool, make sure you continue to maintain your pool right up to the actual closing date and your pool will clean up quicker this coming Spring.**

The first step is to take an end-of-season water sample to your nearest Arvidson location for a computerized analysis. The personal prescription will tell you about any special situations, such as algae or metals in the water, which will need attention before closing the pool. Any problems with water chemistry will not disappear over the winter! Properly preparing your pool for winter now will make opening your pool next year simpler.

Check the condition of your winter cover well in advance of your actual closing. Not only will a sturdy, safe winter cover help prevent accidents, but it will also minimize contamination during the winter. **If you suspect that your cover needs repair or replacement, call Arvidson's as soon as possible for a free quote.**

When is the best time to close my pool? Arvidson's suggests that the earliest you want to close your pool would be when all the leaves have fallen off the trees. If your pool is closed too early, you will need to open it earlier in the Spring season. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Arvidson's.

Does Arvidson's offer warranty coverage on winterizations? Although Arvidson's has an excellent history of protecting pools and spas from freeze breaks and other damages, it is impossible to guarantee that shifting ground conditions or aging underground pipes will never effect your pool. Freeze breaks are easily identified once the location of the leak has been found. Freeze breaks have specific characteristics that make them easily identifiable as compared to other types of breaks or leaks in lines. **All freeze breaks** that are clearly identified as such will be covered as long as all the terms and conditions of the closing contract were met on completion of the work.

Important Notices In Regards To Closings Contracted By Arvidson Pools & Spas:

- Technicians must have access to install a solid cover. **Arvidson does will not remove decking to apply a cover and assumes no responsibility for solid covers that do not stay positioned on the pool.**
- **All contracts must include full payment and be signed before they can be scheduled.**
- Contracts will be scheduled on a **First Come – First Serve** basis. Once scheduled, you will be promptly notified in regards to which day we have you scheduled.
